



“Recommend A Friend” Referral Scheme Guide

How to log into our referral portal

We’ve made it easy to track how you are doing with your referrals and to share your unique referrer’s weblink with friends and neighbours.

The first thing you need to know is how to access our simple referral portal, which has all the information you need on how any referrals you’ve made are proceeding (and also some very simple ways to share your unique weblink – but more on that later).

To log into our referral portal, just visit www.4G-internet.co.uk/referral. If you don’t get automatically logged in and instead see a page asking for your email, first name and last name, just pop in your email address, hit Enter and you’ll then be able to view all your referrer’s information.

It’s easy to recommend our 4G broadband service to others

With our Referral Scheme, there are many ways you can share a recommendation with friends, neighbours and family.

This is a great way to let people who still have the same frustratingly slow broadband that you used to have know that there’s an immediately available and cost-effective answer out there – which is something they’re bound to welcome knowing about. And if they subscribe to our service, as a thankyou to you, we’ll give you one month’s 4G broadband entirely free of charge.

Remember – if anyone clicks the unique referrer weblink you’ve been given and subsequently places an order or logs an enquiry, they’ll be

automatically tracked throughout our sales process and you'll be rewarded if they stay with our 4G broadband service beyond their 14-day cooling off period.

Facebook

Facebook is a great way to share your recommendation. Lots of people don't realise just how much of a broadband improvement they'll see by joining our service – they'll finally be enabled to take advantage of all those online activities that they simply couldn't do before. Here's a quick example of the sort of Facebook post that you might choose to use:

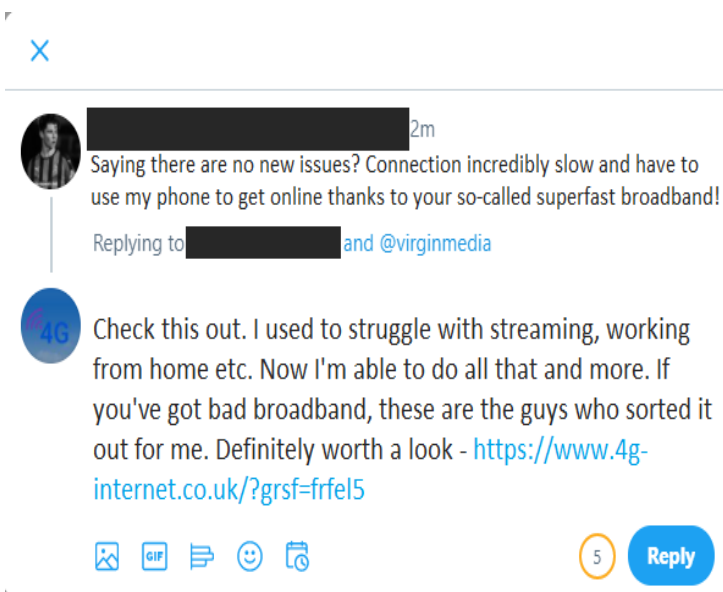
Sharing couldn't be simpler. Just go to our website referral scheme page at www.4G-internet.co.uk/referral and click on the "share" link in the bottom left-hand corner. From there choose to "share via Facebook", personalise the message however you like (the above is only an example). Just make sure you include your unique weblink in your post!

Where else is good to share on Facebook?

Facebook has a number of places where it would be both suitable and useful to share your recommendation. You may want to post in a local community group if you know of others in your area who are struggling with bad broadband, or share to a Facebook page if you think it'd be of interest. Others choose to share via FB Messenger or just post their link in comments on any relevant post.

Some of our customers have even been known to share their unique weblink in the comments section of other internet providers when they see a fellow person struggling. It's up to you!

Twitter



Do you ever see people complaining on Twitter about their bad broadband? Well with your unique weblink you can let them know about a solution. Just tell them about the 4G broadband service you've got from us and how quick and easy it was to get up and running.

Instagram

Maybe not somewhere you'd expect to post about your new much improved broadband, but wouldn't others like to know?

So why not post a picture of either a speed test, or your newly set-up router (and antenna if you went for the full install) or even a smiling selfie expressing relief that your problems are solved. Just make sure in the caption you include your unique weblink so anyone seeing your post knows where to go for our solution.

Here's some example text for you to copy and paste if you like (but remember to include your unique weblink!)

Email

We've made sharing your recommendation by email as easy as possible, with a couple of ways to do this. Just navigate to "Send an Email invite" in our referrals partner portal, enter the email address of whoever it is that you want to know about our 4G broadband service – and our system will automatically send them your unique weblink.

Alternatively, you may want to send a personalised email to an individual. Or perhaps you're part of an email group that you think could benefit from hearing about our broadband. Simply type your email message as normal and just paste in your unique weblink.

WhatsApp/SMS Text

One of the easiest ways to share your link is over WhatsApp or via text. From our referrals partner portal, all you need do is choose the relevant sharing option, enter the recipient's contact info and type a message of your choice. Our system will take care of the rest for you
